

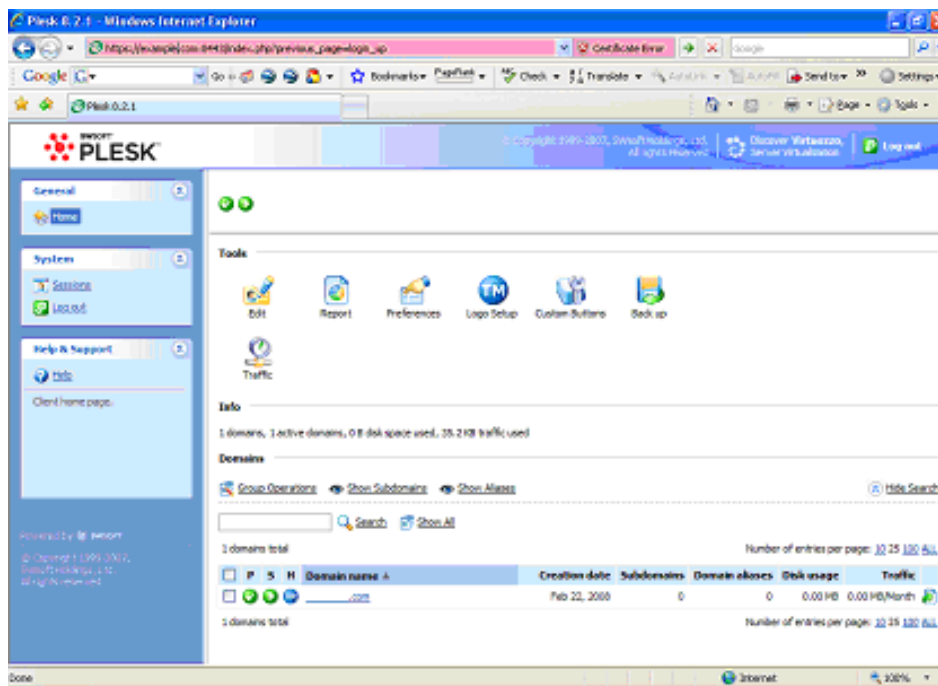
Introduction

This tutorial explains how to change your passwords for logging in to the Plesk control panel and FTP access to your site.

Throughout this guide you need to substitute your domain name for example.com

Changing Plesk Password

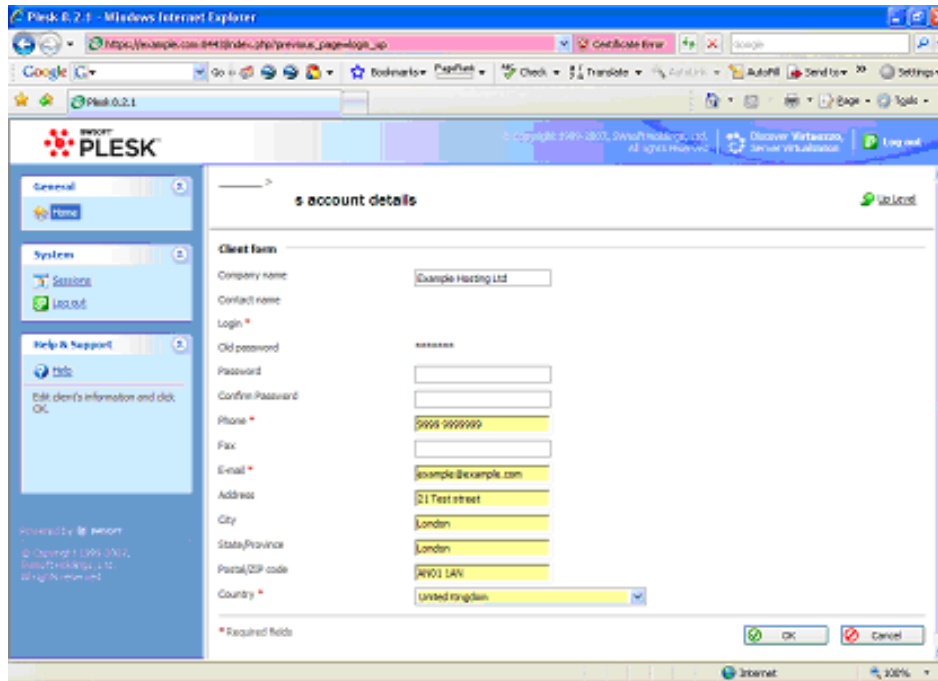
If not already logged in, login to your Plesk control panel.



Plesk main page

From the control panel main page click on the edit icon.

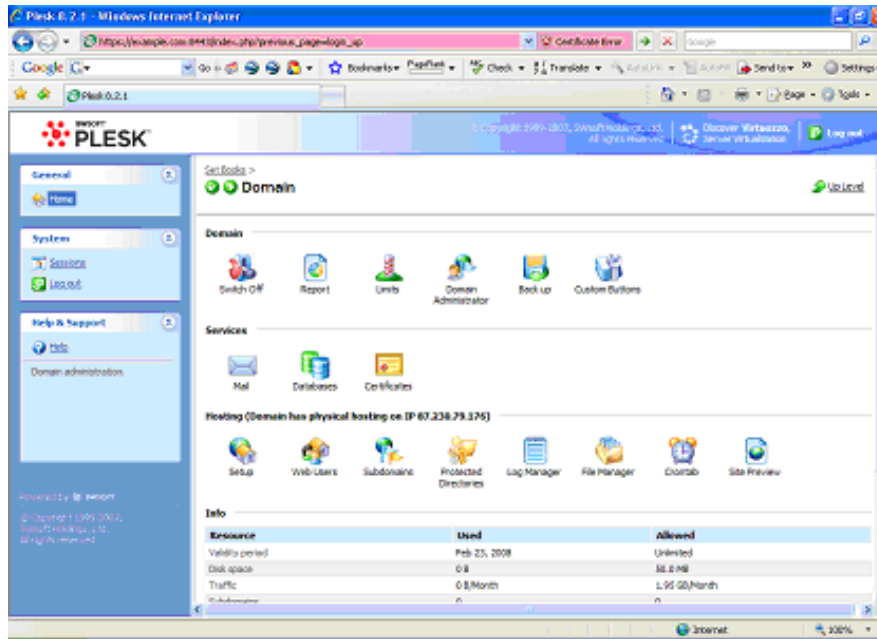
This will take you to the account details page and allow you to select a new password. Enter your new password into the password field and then the confirm password field. Click 'OK' to save changes. You may also use this screen to amend your contact details or change your contact email.



Account details page

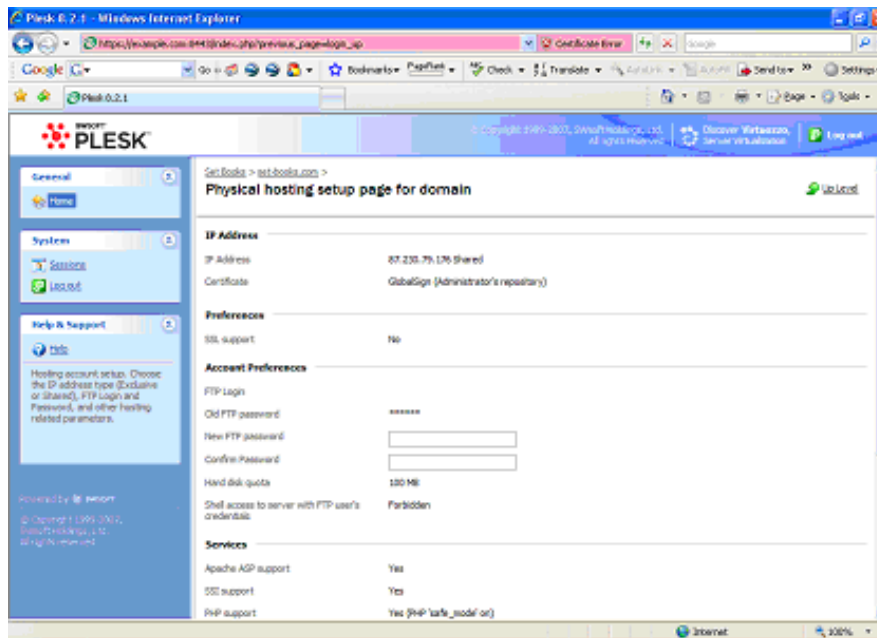
Changing ftp Password

From the control panel main page, click on the domain that you wish to change the ftp password. This will take you to the domain management page.



Domain management page

Click on the setup icon in the hosting section to access the hosting set-up page.



Hosting set-up page

As with the control panel password, enter your new password in the new ftp password and confirm password fields and click 'OK' to save.

Should you ever forget your password to Plesk, access the Plesk login page for your domain. From here there is a link that will send a password reminder to your email address that you used when signing up for your account.

If you forget the FTP password, a new one can be created as described in this tutorial.
